Please read the information on these pages to understand the commitment involved in joining FRC Team 7460. Prior to and after the start of the build season, we will have Tech training classes, outreach opportunities, and team-building activities.

The following document is to not only provide you with some information about the opportunities available with Avi and Friends, but it will also give us the ability to get to know you more.

FIRST Robotics Competition has quite a variety of tasks during both the “build season” and “off-season”. Off-season meetings begin Mid-May and occur on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Mondays of each month, 6-8 pm. Build season officially kicks off in early January. After kick-off, team members that have signed up for certain subgroups will meet with their lead mentor to create a timeline, meeting days, and group tasks for their subgroup. Members should be prepared to and plan to attend all sessions for their subgroup. There will be levels of participation and recognition depending on the number of hours you commit to the season.

**PARENTS:** There are opportunities for parents to help with the team. There are both technical and non-technical areas of service. You are very important in every aspect of our success. Parents are a key factor in the motivation and dedication of your student. Supporting your son/daughter in all aspects of team involvement is key to getting the most from this program.

Team 7460 depends on funding provided by member team fees and sponsors to cover the team expenses such as registration fees, building components, and travel fees. The FRC Team 7460 activity fee for the season is \$500 per participant. This could be reduced based on fundraising success. Travel costs are about \$450 per tournament. We will compete in 2 events, possibly 3 if we qualify. The team fee is due 30 days after kickoff. As always cost should not be a barrier. We have scholarships available for those in need.
